



## Trail blazes ways to combat climate change

A NEW trail to inform locals about native plants and animals was launched in Quinns Rocks this month.

Quinns Rocks Environment Group opened the Climate-Watch trail, which will contribute data to a national program monitoring the impacts of climate change, on August 6.

ClimateWatch program manager Rich Weatherill talked to those attending about the program at the Gumblossom Community Centre, and led a walk down the trail.

He said the trail would help educate volunteers and families to understand the value of native plants and animals.

“Plants and animals that are easy to identify and can be found across the metropolitan region are being monitored,” he said
